

Starter feed for young calves

- Products are highly palatable to improve intake.
- Products have a high natural protein content and are urea free. Urea is not beneficial for the development of young calves.
- Formulated according to the calves' amino acid requirements.
- Contains stock remedies for improved feed conversion rate and health.

FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS

- Clean, fresh drinking water must be available at all times.
- Calves must have access to shade. Heat stress will have a negative effect on the calves' growth performance.
- Feeding cost per kilogram live weight gain is a more accurate criteria than cost per ton of energy concentrate for evaluation of calf rearing costs.
- Feed intake must be monitored on a daily basis.
- Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight.Contact an AFGRI Animal Feeds Technical Advisor

FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Feed *ad lib* from the age of 3 days. Ensure that fresh feed is available at all times.
- 2. Clean feed troughs regularly. Old or contaminated feed will impact feed intake negatively.
- 3. NB. This is a high-density ration. Switch heifers to the Scientific Complete Calf Feed as soon as the daily intake of the starter ration has reached 600g for small frame breeds and 750g for large frame breeds. Heifers can develop acidosis if they eat too much of the starter meal.
